

Adult Services

Residential and Community Supports

We offer a range of programs to help support individuals who are living in a private home with their family, or who have chosen to live independently in the community. Services include both 24 and non-24 hour assistance. Our dedicated team of direct support professionals guide skill development in areas that can include medical, personal care, money management, nutrition and meal preparation, socialization, and community-based services.

Shared Living Arrangements

This service offers those with intellectual and developmental disabilities the opportunity to live in a family environment. Arrangements are established as a result of a highly-individualized process in which the individual and the hosting person or family are determined to share similar life interests and personalities that support a safe, caring and comfortable home environment.

Child Services

Home-Based Therapeutic Services (HBTS) and **Personal Assistance and Support Services (PASS)** provide intensive home and community services to children from birth to age 21, who have special health care needs.

Services are delivered under the supervision of a state-licensed clinician and are provided in the home and in the community to enhance the independence of the child and the entire family. We provide these services throughout the state of Rhode Island to Medicaid-eligible children.

Day and Employment Services

Our Day Services programming allows adults with intellectual and developmental disabilities to participate in a wide array of educational and vocational opportunities designed to meet their needs and interests.

We are certified by the state of Rhode Island as a Rehabilitation Services Vendor. Certification enables us to provide a menu of supports to individuals interested in vocational skill-building, assessment, and job training as well as securing and maintaining paid employment.

ProPartnerships

This self-directed support service enables those with intellectual, developmental and other disabilities to have more control over the services they receive. Our goal is to help you maximize resources, promote self-direction and growth, and gain access to community supports. We provide you with the ability to hire, train and supervise those tasked with providing direct services.
